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It is always your choice to participate

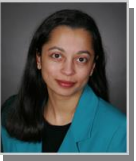

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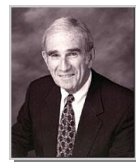

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What is a Clinical Research Study?

Before a new drug or treatment is approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA), it must be shown to be both safe and effective.

Typically this is accomplished by conducting a Clinical Research Study – a carefully controlled trial designed to test and evaluate medications, devices and treatment plans.

Clinical Research Studies are closely monitored by Physicians and Research Professionals.
